The Riverside . . .

The Riverside is situated in Boscastle, one of the picturesque parts of North Cornwall in the Southwest which is nationally recognised as being outstanding for its scenic quality. The Riverside was built around 1584 by Sir Richard Grenville of the Armada fame. He was also the benefactor who provided Boscastle with its fine sea walls. The Riverside, situated along the River Valency, has many spacious rooms with river or harbour views.

The Riverside has been refurbished since the floods in August 2004, being one of the properties experiencing extensive damage throughout. Bringing the building back to a higher standard than once before, all of our thirteen bedrooms at The Riverside have the facilities you should require including:

Full en-suite shower or bath / Freshly laundered towels and bath mats
Full central heating / Tea and coffee making facilities
26" LCD televisions / DVD players / Wireless internet access.

What There is Nearby . . .

Today Boscastle's attractions are drawing tourists from all around the world. With spectacular scenery inland, the old village cottages or the popular rugged coastline, Boscastle has something to offer everyone.

While you are here, why not look at other attractions of Boscastle? The Museum of Witchcraft, now into its 58th year, continues to be one of Cornwall's most popular museums. It shows how Witchcraft has survived into the present with its many large collections and exhibitions. Also visit the unique 60ft waterfall which is at the head of the idyllic wooded valley of St. Nectan's Glen. Situated between Boscastle and Tintagel, the waterfall can be approached by many cliff footpaths.

The Eden Project is described as the global garden for the 21st century, a gateway to a sustainable future and a dramatic setting in which to tell the fascinating story of mankind's dependence on plants. It is already a top international visitor destination and is rapidly becoming a unique resource for education and home to our foundation for the future. Head for St. Austell where Eden is well signposted on all three major routes.

Enjoy Fishing? With 8 hour, 4 hour or 2 hour trips, the "Peganina" is a safe, fast Lochin 33 with all safety equipment for 10 persons and a 20 mile licence. Bookings can be taken at The Rock Shop next door.



Boscastle . . .

Back in the 19th century, Boscastle was a commercial port contributing to Britain's industrial expansion. Before the days of the the railways, which did not reach North Cornwall until 1893, heavy goods were carried by sea. Coal, iron work and limestone from South Wales and fertilisers, timber, corn, wines and spirits from Bristol were the main imports with even cargoes of timber direct from Canada entering the little port. One of the return cargoes was manganese ore from the mine within the Valency Valley itself.

One of the most dominating features of Boscastle is the Valency Valley with the tree canopy harbouring a magnificent landscape. Within the valley the River Valency, a short coursed river, flows down from Marshgate, past The Riverside's secluded garden and on to the harbour in Boscastle. The village lies within a conservation area amongst some of the most beautiful countryside within the British Isles and is one of the few remaining unspoilt harbour villages in Cornwall. Boscastle is a designated area of outstanding natural beauty.

The Riverside is only five minutes from the South West coastal path and is situated at the heart of the village. We are adjacent to all amenities, only a minutes walk away from the Elizabethan Harbour with several restaurants and pubs nearby. For other activities, beaches, a golf course, fishing trips, horse riding and The Eden Project are within a comfortable travelling distance.

Where to find us . . .

From Exeter / Junction 31 of the M5, take the A30 just past Launceston. At the Kennard's House exit signed to North Cornwall, take the A395 where after about 9 miles you will see the signposts to Boscastle. Follow these where you will come to the A39 where you turn left and then immediately right. Follow that road to the B3266 where at the T-junction turn right to Boscastle. As you enter the village, you will pass a garage on your left and at the T-junction, turn right signposted to Boscastle Harbour. Follow this road down. The Riverside is on your right just after the bridge.

From Banstable, take the A39 to Bude. About 10 miles past Bude, take the B3263 signposted to Boscastle. Follow this road into the village and you will go past the car park on your left. The Riverside is located fifty yards further down the road.

We suggest you use the large pay and display car park, fifty yards from The Riverside. The car park charges from 9.30am till 6.00pm each day with no overnight charge. Day and weekly tickets are available. Further information including information of transferable tickets and charges is available from the Boscastle Visitors Centre.

Guest Information . . .

- * **Breakfast** is served between 8.30 and 10.30am daily in the Riverside Restaurant on the ground floor. Breakfast is included within the tariff price and includes a choice of fruit juices, tea and coffee, cereals and traditional English Breakfast. We also cater for vegetarians,
- * We ask you to **vacate** your room by 11.00am each morning for rooms either to be serviced or changed.
- * The Riverside has a strict **non-smoking policy** throughout the premises.
- * We regret that The Riverside has no facilities to accommodate pets.
- * The Riverside can provide a **cot** free of charge however guests are asked to provide their own bedding.
- * Other facilities that The Riverside does provide are the use of **hairdryers** which can be collected at reception.
- * There is a public **telephone** only outside of the premises by the car park and access to the use of a computer for **email** and **Internet** services at the Visitors Centre.
- * We accept all major **credit and debit cards** with the exception of American Express. Cash is always welcome.
- * We require a **deposit** to complete any reservation if details of credit or debit cards are not taken.
- * Each booking made is on the bases of five days minimum notice of **cancellation**. A full cancellation policy is available on our website.
