Overlooking the River Valency, the Riverside Restaurant is a great spot to relax with family and friends. We offer teas, coffees, lunches, a large variety of homemade cakes and Cornish Cream Teas.

In the lazy hazy crazy days of summer, relax by the River Valency and enjoy a day time snack or early evening meal in our exclusive Tea Garden. Share a piece of bread with the river ducks or spot the dipper bird as it bathes in the water.

During the evening, the Riverside Restaurant uses local suppliers offering a widespread selection of regional produce including locally caught fish, farmed meats and fresh vegetables. The Flame-Grill Menu includes a selection of steaks (sirloin, rump and ribeye) lamb, chicken and pork served to your liking and with all the trimmings. Fish dishes (locally landed) are displayed along with the Main Menu and these are changed daily.

Sunday afternoons throughout the year we offer a traditional carvery. With a choice of four local meats and up to seven fresh vegetables, homemade Yorkshire puddings, stuffing and gravy. It is best to book early.

Located on the ground floor of the building, we have a fully licensed bar offering draught lagers and bitter, local ales and beers, spirits and soft drinks.



We have a 56 seater restaurant and in nice weather we have up to 80 seats outside in our Tea Garden. We can accommodate for large bookings, i.e.
